Here's how it works: Fill out the Registration form <https://forms.gle/DPuWTC5FAe3a7crWA> and click on "Submit." You will receive two replying emails:

- One, from us, confirms that you have completed Step One. This first message will arrive soon after you register.
- A second, from Zoom, prompts you to complete your registration by registering for the zoom site. The second message will arrive in late December, a few days before camp begins. Look for it.
- You will also get an informative message or two from the Camp Harmony committee, alerting you to details that may improve your experience with us online.

And that's it! Note that Registration for camp closes at 12 noon pacific time on Tuesday, December 28th. Sign up now or soon, mark your calendar or glowing screen, and look for the zoom message to complete the registration circuit.

Tune your instrument and voice, sharpen your listening, update Zoom on your device, stock up on nourishing snacks, and prepare for four days unlike any others.

SFFMC member directory available online!

The first SFFMC member directory in many years is now available! It's an online directory at <https://www.sffmc.org/member-directory>. The directory can only be viewed by current members who are logged into the website. If you haven't logged in before and you have trouble logging in, see the instructions at <https://www.sffmc.org/update-your-info>.

A few things to know:

The directory only shows current members who want to be shown in the directory. Expired members and members who prefer not to be shown in the directory do not appear.

The directory only shows the information that a member wants to show, which can range from just the member's name to complete contact information, with various options in between.

The directory listings are shown alphabetically by member's first name. This is not ideal, but it would be difficult for us to modify. However, the directory is fully searchable by first or last name by using the Search Members box on the right.

September Board Meeting Highlights

Storage Area. Our space is at Bridge Storage and Art Space in Richmond. Our storage space is 10X10 by 9' high. Hours to access storage are 6:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. We can have late access on request.

Because we are a non-profit, we get a discount. Our monthly rent is \$193.50 and our deposit is \$40 (refundable). It's month to month; we can leave at any time.

Bob Helliesen has a copy of the lease agreement and we have 2 fobs for the storage area. He met with Ed Sherry's agent who passed over the equipment Ed had donated to the Club. We will need to buy shelving. Bob will look around and price it. The Board approved Bob getting the shelving.

Hali contacted our insurance company, ISU. They let her know that the carrier will add the storage unit insurance to the general liability and property coverage. They are not charging any additional premium to add this to the property policy this term, so there will be \$0 additional cost to us to add the storage space insurance to both policies. Bob let Bridge Storage know that we are covered and don't have to pay the \$10 per month for insurance through their storage facility. Hali sent proof of insurance to the storage company.

Folknik. Donna is stepping down as editor after the next issue and her co-editor Bob Loomis is also stepping down at the same time. Craig Johnson has offered to orient Daniel on using Adobe software for production/layout of a print-friendly *folknik*. Daniel could just post *folknik* articles on the website formatted as HTML, but it wouldn't be easily printable as an entire *folknik* issue. We have to make a decision soon. Daniel has been the liaison with Donna for months. Is the *folknik* sustainable? What would an entirely different way to look at a newsletter look like? Many people now are only doing things online. Do we need to have a print copy? We can't resolve it now but can continue the discussion. There are a lot of things to consider. Note: if you are willing to help with the *folknik*, contact Donna or Daniel.

Membership. Daniel reported that Membership is almost totally switched over to Membership Pro. People have been getting notices that their dues are due. The website now directs

people to the Memberships Pro page and the old system is pretty much retired.

Singing for Justice. The fundraiser for Faith's movie raised the \$30,000 they needed to make their Kickstarter goal. The Board passed a motion to donate \$1000 to the project. We can also put out the word and encourage other people to donate.

Camp Herms Labor Day Camp. Report from Hali. (See article on P.8 of the September/October folknik.)

ECFFF. Daniel has provided tech support. We're currently attracting bands and workshops. The Festival will be online this year. The Assistant City Manager of the City of El Cerrito did not want to support live events this year due to the pandemic so even though we checked out the El Cerrito Community Center several times it was not available for us.

Camp Harmony. (See the article on the front page of the September/October *folknik* from the committee.) Committee meetings to plan a virtual Camp Harmony have started. People in other folk communities are looking at what our community is doing to keep thriving during the pandemic. Camp Harmony will be free except we will ask for donations. The committee is situated well to put on this year's Harmony.

Cyprian's. Ed reported that it is doing well, "chugging along online." Cyprian's does not want in-person groups yet. Tuesdays are much like Fridays but have about half of Friday's participants (10-12 as compared with about 20-25)

Next meeting will be at Ed Hilton's Tuesday October 12.
