## 2023 Labor Day Weekend Report

We made the rent! Final tally for money collected was \$2,918 and the camp rental was \$2,700 so we actually made a profit!

We spent \$11 on copies of the waivers and site maps which was our only expense aside from the rental.

We had 14 overnight campers on Friday night, 15 on Saturday (2 from Friday were day use Saturday but we gained 3 more overnight on Saturday) and 9 overnight campers on Sunday. We had 5 day use Friday, 81 day use Saturday, 30 day use Sunday. So we had 19 total for Friday, 96 total for Saturday and 39 total for Sunday. The 96 total on Saturday was our highest single day count since we've been at Camp Herms.

We had plenty of helpers to clean up Monday and I had everything closed up by 1 pm.

## The Marlboro Medley

by *Patience Young*

The “Marlboro Medley,” a twelve-verse song, was written in 1787 in Vermont, rediscovered in mid-20th century, and recorded by Margaret MacArthur for Folkways in 1962. It’s essentially a shopping list of items offered by Yankee peddlers at the time, an unusual song awaiting attention. In September (2023) I gave an illustrated presentation on this little-known song for the Traditional Song Forum. Here are the lyrics, a link to MacArthur’s recording, and a link to my talk. Give yourself about a half hour to read, hear, and see.

### The lyrics:

The Marlboro Medley — Tune Black-Joke  
written by Mr. [Daniel?] Greenleaf, Brattleboro, VT,  
1787

This is transcribed from the original manuscript, held by the Vermont Folklife Center, with its capitalizations, punctuation, and indentations.

Omissions have been added in brackets and italicized.

When Marlboro Merchants set out for Pedling,  
Made lawful by custom (let none be meddling)  
Barter is legal when trading for grain. —

With wherry & Horses, see how they turn out,  
Each Pedlar taking his different rout[e]  
With notions & things both curious & common,  
To please Men & Children & gratify Women  
Which I shall here attempt to name. —

Their Budgets consist of variety —  
There's no two Pungs whose loads agree,  
Each Pedlar hath his different ware, —

Whirls & spindles, Jews harps & thimbles  
Shoemakers Lasts & Peg-awls & wimbles,  
Dippers & Noggins & Canns to make grog in  
To barter for corn— “Have you any to spare”?

Here comes the Bowls & wooden dishes,  
Sleek looking trouts, “most exelent fishes” —  
From Marlboro's ponds & holes in the Brook —

Where in winter, a fishing they go,  
Up to their waist-bands thro the snow,  
There, thro’ the ice they cut a hole,  
Then they fish without a pole—  
Dextrous Anglers with a hook.

Lo Hog-yoaks, Goose-Yoaks, Taps & fassets  
(And Tools to make them, Jack-knives and Hatchets)  
To hamper your piggs, Your Geese, and draw beer.  
With parchment screens to clean Flax-seed  
Cheese-tongs, wooden fans & weaver's Reeds,  
Great spinning wheels & Swifts & Reels  
And Snow-shoes strung from Toe to heel  
To run on the crust & catch the Deer. —

“Come buy our Bread-trophs, buy our sieves,  
To sift your meal from bran & shives, —  
Different sorts both hide & hair, —

Half-Bushels and Pecks (all made by guess,)  
Two Quart Dippers, (a thousand or less,)  
Poaks, Ox-Yoaks, & hopples for Horses,  
Straw-hats & Bonnetts for Lads & Lasses,  
Good as the best, the Gentry wear.” —

Now comes the Baskets & the Rakes  
Enough to supply the Thirteen States  
Besides a large pile of new made Chairs. —

Pails, Pipkins, & Tubs, for washing & brewing  
Great wooden-platters to take up your stew in  
Brooms, Dye-pots & Keelers, salt-mortars, & pestles  
Pudding-sticks, Ladles, whip-stocks & whistles  
Beside wooden spoons as plenty as hairs. —

Here comes the Turnips & fine Bobbin-lace,  
Braided-bark mittens, (your hands to case,)  
A rare invention, every one says, —

Saddle-tree-woods & Birch-barrel-bottles,  
Shoe-make[rs] spools & Iron-wood shuttles,  
Besoms & oven lids, (handy when baking),  
Boxes for flour & Trays to make Cake in  
And Wickopy stay-tape to lace up the Stays—

But now we must leave the ingenious Mechanic,  
And sing how Root Doctors pursue their Botanic-  
al Rambles thro Forrests O'er Hills & the Plain,

To dig blue Cohosh and sarsaparilla  
Green Pettymorrel and purple a[n]geli-  
ca Snake-root & Ginseng & modest Wild Piony,  
The Root for Consumption & mending old China,  
With Poke-root & Blood-root & Ellecampane. —

In early settling the Town, one Year  
They'd no luck in hunting the Bear or the Deer,  
No Bread to be had, Potatoes were scarce:

Then had the Small-pox with all its infection  
Have pass'd through the Town in every direction,  
It could not have touched such dioted Men,  
Where dozens could breakfast on Robin or Wren —  
Disease disappointed must sneak from the place. —

But now they fare better, they've some thing to eat,  
Various fowls & four footed meat,  
Partridge & Wood-cock & Wild Turkey-hen.

Geese, Pigeons & Ducks, Skunks & Woodchucks,  
Lusty Rackcoons well fatted with nutts,  
Porcupines, squirrels & Rabbits & Hares,  
For Beef they [have] moose, for Pork they have bears  
And saddles of Venison now and then. —

A Pung or two more brings up the rear,  
With Green Spruce-boughs for brewing Beer,  
Rosin of Hemlock & Hack metack gum,

Balsam of Fir & sugar of maple,  
Lime, Shingles and Salts, (The Marlboro staples)  
Red-ochre, Sal-Petre, & Butter-nutt physic  
Assmart-pills, a cure for the phthiysic  
And Candy — Black-Strap\* too stubborn to run.

And now my Medley draws nigh a close,  
A rap on my knuckles, or wring of my Nose,  
Shan't hinder my Toast, I'll out with it here,

May Manufacturers long abound  
In this Mechanical Pedling Town,  
And may those sons whose Sires are dead !  
Have as good means to get their Bread  
As their [ ] have had for many years.

\*- Black Strap — commonly called W\_\_[?] made by  
pouring hot molasses on the snow, which prevents[?] granulation.

*Note the omission [ ] in the last line.*

*There's no word here, nor space for one on the  
handwritten page. Margaret MacArthur recorded the  
final line thus:*

As their **Fathers** have had **this many a year.**

Music meetings are held via Zoom on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of every month, at 7:00 p.m., and on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesdays of every month, at 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. There are breakout rooms. ## September Board Meeting Highlights

**Finances:** Dave reported:

Bank of the West is now BMO (based in Montreal, Canada) and we will continue to bank with them.

**Board Elections:** Ed Hilton, Charlie Fenton, Jerry Michaels and Dave Sahn are up for election.

Each person was asked if they wanted to be re-elected. Charlie moved to accept Ed; Dave seconded. Ed moved to accept Charlie; Hali seconded. Ed moved to accept Dave; Daniel seconded. Ed moved to accept Jerry; Hali seconded. Everyone was re-elected unanimously.

**folknik:** Deadline for the November/December issue is October 15. Charlie: The last issue was the longest folknik ever and had lots of large color photos. It's great that the newer format makes this possible.

**Camp Herms:** Report from Hali. We had the Labor Day camp from Friday September 1 – Monday September 4. We made the rent! I deposited \$2888. Norm Bowen donated \$60 to Ellen Eagan as part of a yearly donation to the Club, so we made \$2948 for the weekend. Since the camp rental was \$2700, we actually made a profit of \$248, minus \$11 on copies of the waivers and site maps which was our only expense aside from the rental. I took it out of the cash before depositing it. I kept the copying receipt. Total profit was \$237.

We had 14 overnight campers on Friday night, 15 on Saturday (2 from Friday were day use Saturday, but we gained 3 more overnight on Saturday) and 9 overnight campers on Sunday.

We had 5 day-use Friday, 81 day-use Saturday, 30 day-use Sunday.

**ECFFF:** Hali reported Fat Daddy's BBQ will be our vendor; we are getting the permit taken care of for him. Bob and Bryan Uhlenbrock have a complete lineup of performers and will be getting the order soon. Catherine de Neergaard is taking care of workshops. Elly Faden said she'd help with volunteers. We don't have a kid's program this year. Hali will take care of the website. Postcards will be available soon.

**Camp Harmony:** Charlie reported that registration will start in a few days. We need to get the word out and encourage people to come. There is a flyer available. People are required to test negative for Covid 6 hours before they come to camp and bring proof that they are negative. There will be a shuttle bus through Marin Airpoter, the same company we have used in the past.

**SFFFF:** Daniel reported that at the post festival meeting, they talked about next year and their level of commitment. Pete Kronowitt and Daniel met with Illuminate, the group that hosted us at Golden Gate Park this year, The SFFFF core team are all inclined to return to Golden Gate Park next year rather than going back to a school location. They reached many more people than they ever did at a school and the sound is taken care of. There are possible dates, but this doesn't have to be decided until December.
